## Central Market Tour and Rice Show Cooking

The tour will depart from the cruise terminal\* by bus, accompanied by an official guide\*.

On route to the city's central market, you will enjoy panoramic views of the most emblematic places in the city which will be explained by our guide.

You will visit Alicante's Central Market, a building with modernist-inspired elements.

With the help of the guide you will learn about Alicante's gastronomy and the Mediterranean diet, including the most typical produce and how they are prepared.

After visiting the market, you will go to a restaurant where a rice dish will be prepared. You will learn how it is made, the ingredients used, the seasons, etc.

Customers will be offered red and white Alicante D.O. wines or sangria, beer, soft drinks or water accompanied by various snacks.

Once the rice is ready, customers will be able to taste it seated at the table.

## Tapas Tour With Visit to Central Market

The tour will depart from the cruise terminal\* by bus, accompanied by an official guide\*.

On the way to the city's central market, you will see the most unique places in the area which will be explained by our guide- You will also try your first tapa.

Guided tour of Alicante's Central Market, a building with modernist-inspired elements. It was constructed under the direction of J. Vidal Ramos, between 1911 and 1912, on the 18<sup>th</sup>-century wall that surrounded Alicante.

You will learn about Alicante's gastronomy and the Mediterranean diet, including our most typical produce, how they are prepared (such as sausages), the seasons for fish and fruit, etc.

After the visit, you will continue to explore the city, the historic part of the Santa Cruz neighbourhood, stopping to enjoy various tapas of local dishes, such as Alicante rice dishes, Spanish omelette, etc.

All tapas will be accompanied by a glass of red or white Alicante D.O. wine, beer, soft drink, water or herbal tea.

At the end, you will have free time to enjoy the atmosphere and interact with the other attendees.



#### Servilleta and Ricotta Cheese Workshop

Servilleta cheese is a fresh cheese that originates from the province of Alicante and is currently widespread in the Valencian Community.

The first person to make this variety of cheese was the grandmother of the master cheesemaker who runs the workshops. Mrs. Chelo Martínez, finalist in the best cheese board of Spain judged in the Best Spanish Cheese Championship 2022.

ITINERARY:

Departure by shuttle bus from the cruise terminal accompanied by an English-speaking gastronomic guide.

The workshop will last 2 to 2.5 hours, during which our customers, guided by the master cheesemaker and chef, will follow the whole process of making Servilleta and ricotta cheese. Each customer will be able to make their own cheese.

After the workshop, you will go back to the shuttle bus stop and return to the ship. Workshop duration: 2 to 2.5 hours










#### Pilgrimage to Santa Faz



Every year in which 17th March falls on a Sunday, the Holy See has granted the privilege of declaring it a Jubilee Year in the Monastery of the Holy Face of Alicante.

Its pilgrimage is the second most popular in Spain, after that of El Rocio.

Departure from the cruise terminal with a guide who will accompany you throughout the tour.

(Wheelchair users will be accompanied by the guide to the TRAM stop. Other customers will travel by shuttle bus).

The journey starts with the TRAM, a form of sustainable transport, in a reserved carriage. You will stop at a strategic spot to enjoy and discover important places in the city and its history. This part of the tour can be done on foot or in a wheelchair until you reach your destination.

Customers will be given a handkerchief worn by the people of Alicante on the day of the pilgrimage.

Along the way you can enjoy local produce that pilgrims usually enjoy.

Arrival at the monastery, visit and explanation of the Camarín de la Santa Faz, an enigmatic place in which the Santa Faz is kept.

After the visit, you will enjoy a tapa and a drink before returning to the TRAM and the cruise terminal.

#### La Marjal Park, San Juan Beach

La Marjal Flood Park is located a short distance from San Juan Beach, in an urban area developed on land that was once a marshland. It is a unique park which, in addition to the leisure and recreational function of any park, fulfils another hydraulic function: in the event of heavy rainfall it serves as a rainwater retention basin. It has a large pond surrounded by aquatic vegetation where you can observe the flora and fauna typical of the natural Valencian wetlands (marshes).

This park was awarded the Alhambra prize for the best project of the year 2015 by the Spanish Association of Public Parks and Gardens.

Excursion:

Departure from the cruise terminal by shuttle bus accompanied by a guide specialised in the subject of the excursion, water, flora, fauna and archaeology to transfer to the TRAM stop, a form of sustainable transport, in a reserved carriage. Throughout the journey you will observe different important places in the city in terms of water enclaves, including some of the Torres de las Huertas and watchtowers declared of national interest. This will all be explained by the guide.

Transfer to the park and guided tour. Duration approx. 1.5 hours.

After the visit, you will go to Espacio Lo Gozo, where you will be given a ticket to enjoy a bite to eat at any of their FOOD TRUCKS.

Return at the agreed time via the TRAM and shuttle bus. End of service.

Customers will be treated to some Horchata with a fartón (a traditional Valencian sweet) and cold almond milk with coca de almendra (almond cake).

Once finished, you will be collected and returned to the cruise terminal by bus.

During this tasting not only will you taste delicious drinks and exquisite cheeses carefully selected for you, but you will also experience their aromas, textures and nuances.

You will experience how the flavours develop on your palate, from the smooth creaminess to the intensity of the cured cheeses accompanied by sweet, fruity or spicy notes, creating the perfect combination.

The aromas will transport you to green pastures, meadows, ancient wine cellars.... Each sense plays an essential role:

Sight will allow you to appreciate the different colours, eyes and veins in the cheese.

Sound will help you hear the intensity when cutting the cheese.

Touch will allow you to discover its consistency and texture.

After visiting the bullring, your guide will take you to discover the charm of Alicante's old town, strolling through its streets steeped in history, its picturesque corners and its Mediterranean atmosphere.

To top off this experience with the best flavour, you will enjoy a delicious tapa tasting in one of the city's restaurants, where your palate will join the tour in a perfect combination of culture and gastronomy.

Among them is the majestic date tree: it can grow up to 20 metres tall and its impressive leaves can measure up to 7 metres long. Strolling along its paths and over its wooden bridges is an immersive experience that connects visitors with the natural beauty of the place.

## Cave Houses and Artisan Artichoke and Vegetable Canning Factory

Departure from the cruise terminal by bus, accompanied by our official English-speaking guide\*. You will head towards the Vega Baja, the so-called GARDEN OF EUROPE. The first stop will be in the village of Rojales. You will visit 'Las Cuevas del Rodeo' cave-houses, dug into the rock between the 18th and 20th centuries, which form a traditional housing complex that is now an open-air museum showcasing the local history and culture.

Nowadays, as a museum, they constitute the extensive Ecomuseum of the Municipal Underground Habitat, in which each cave-house forms a workshop, gallery or exhibition space.

Following this visit, you will visit 'La Vieja Dolores' in Almoradí, the last canning factory of the renowned artichoke and canned beans, tomatoes, etc.

The factory manager will explain the production process and will end the tour with a tasting of these products accompanied by Alicante D.O. wines.

Departure to the city of Alicante at the agreed time and return to the cruise terminal.

Perfect for travellers looking for more than just a simple walk, this tour invites you to experience life as a local in Alicante.

#### Kayaking - Paddle Surfing at San Juan beach

NYour adventure begins as you depart the cruise terminal by bus, accompanied by an English-speaking instructor (other languages available upon request), to San Juan beach. ## Guadalest: History, Show and Gastronomic Workshop

Departure by bus\* accompanied by an official guide\* to El Castell de Guadalest, which is recognised as one of the most beautiful villages in Spain. This municipality dates back to the Muslim period.

Arrival, tour of the wonderful old town and free time to enjoy the beautiful shops. Possibility to visit the museum house.

You will then visit a sausage factory. The sausages from this area are nationally renowned.

Tour of the factory, explanation of what types of sausages are made, how they are made, ingredients used, etc.

Afterwards, you will enjoy a barbecue as the locals usually do on public holidays, including various types of sausages and meats, accompanied by salads made with local vegetables, as well as cheese and wine, beer, soft drinks and water.

#### **Lucentum and Gourmet Tapas**



You will depart from the cruise terminal by bus\*, accompanied by an official guide\*. A panoramic journey throughout which the guide will explain the sights.

FIRST STOP: Guided tour of the city of Lucentum (entry included).

Located 3 kilometres from the city centre, in the area known as Tossal de Manises, are these significant archaeological remains from the Iberian-Roman period, which belonged to the Roman city of Lucentum, the ancient city of Alicante. It covers 5 hectares, of which 2.5 hectares correspond to the old population centre. It is therefore one of the most significant archaeological sites in the Valencian Community.

SECOND STOP: You will then go to Almadraba beach to see the archaeological remains of the Roman fish farm, which was located next to Albufera beach. There you will learn how the Romans preserved live fish for daily consumption.

THIRD STOP: You will visit the residential area of Alicante, San Juan beach, and taste 3 gourmet tapas in restaurants recognised by the best gastronomic guides.

Duration: recommended 4 hours.

## The Alicante Olive Oil Tour and Modernist Alcoy

Departure from the cruise terminal by MINIBUS\* to the olive oil farm, accompanied by an official guide\*.

Rustic country estate located in a narrow valley, surrounded by mountains, pine trees, holm oaks, junipers, ash trees, maples, gall oaks, etc. Half of the country estate is within the Font Roja Natural Park, and the other half within the Sierra de Mariola Natural Park, a place of extraordinary beauty. Sierra de Mariola Natural Park is, in the opinion of many renowned botanists, the mountain range with the greatest variety of aromatic and medicinal plants in the world.

You will visit the farmhouse, guided by a sommelier, who will explain the whole process, as well as the importance and characteristics of olive growing in high mountain areas. You will also visit the olive groves themselves.

Afterwards, you will head to the city of Alcoy for a 1.5-hour guided tour of the architectural modernism of the city, during which you will learn about the situation during that time, class struggle, social revolutions, anecdotes, as well as references and comparisons with other buildings of similar style.
